

WELCOME TO MEYERSDALE

Tucked in the Casselman River Valley, in the shadow of Pennsylvania's highest point, Mount Davis, Meyersdale welcomes visitors to share its rich history and small town charm.

The Meyersdale area was first occupied by the Monongahela Indians, who captured the sweet water from maple trees to make maple syrup. In celebration of this rich tradition, Meyersdale has hosted the Pennsylvania Maple Festival for more than 60 years. The "Maple City" welcomes thousands for the annual festival in late March.

This sweetest of all the Trail Towns boasts more than maple syrup, of course. Repurposed rail structures like the Salisbury and Keystone viaducts, Bollman Bridge, and Big Savage Tunnel are nearby on the Great Allegheny Passage.

The town itself is experiencing a renaissance, with the completion of a major streetscape improvement project. At the trail access area, visit the Western Maryland Railway Station. The train station-turned-visitor center includes local history and photography exhibits as well as a retail store that benefits the local historical society.

As you head into town, take notice of the mural on Main Street. It's one of several along the Great Allegheny Passage and pays homage to Meyersdale's roots as a bustling transportation hub for local agriculture, coal, and timber.
